A Little History

The first Fall Folk Festival in 1996 was held at the Unitarian Church with a dozen performing groups. When "Ice Storm" happened only around 350 people attended.

The Festival grew rapidly. It outgrew the Unitarian Church after three years and moved to Glover Middle School for several years.

Now the Festival packs The Lair at Spokane Community College with over 6,000 attendees and showcases nearly 75 performing groups.

The Festival is made possible by hundreds of volunteers and performers who donate time and energy to make this festival a success and by folks who donate money and/or services.
